



HIGH SCHOOL (EARLY ENTRY) STUDENT VERIFICATION
(Must be submitted to records prior to or at the time of registration.)

High school students with junior or senior standing may enroll in college courses at Southern WV Community and Technical College provided they meet the course prerequisites and the following requirements:

1. Completion of a consent form signed by the high school principal or counselor and parent.
2. The student must have a 3.0 (B) average. (Students may enroll in non-college level courses with less than a 3.00 grade point average.)
3. Juniors may take classes totaling no more than 4 credit hours per semester.
4. Seniors may enroll for no more than 7 credit hours per semester unless otherwise approved by the Vice President for Academic Affairs or his/her designee.
5. Early entry students must meet prerequisite test scores before registering for college-level English and/or Math courses.

If you are a high school junior or senior, you must ask your principal or counselor to complete this form. A parent or guardian must also sign approval for attendance.
